H. E. Mr. Yury Fedotov, Executive Director (Under Secretary General), United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC), Vienna will be visiting Bhutan from December 7-9, 2014. During the visit, Mr. Fedotov will receive an Audience with His Majesty the King, call on the Hon'ble Prime Minister and meet with senior government officials. He will also visit UNODC supported de-addiction center for men and women.

UNODC was established in 1997 as part of the UN reform combining the previous United Nations Drug Control Programme and the Center for International Crime Prevention. UNODC helps Members States address illicit drugs, crime and terrorism. UNODC Regional Office for South Asia (ROSA) was established in 1987 and is based in New Delhi, India. ROSA works in six countries: Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal and Sri Lanka.

UNODC has established a project office in Bhutan in April 2014.
